Alison Parry graduated from Southampton Solent University in July 2006, with a BA in Fine Art. Since then she has worked in galleries and continued with her artwork, exhibiting in and around the South of England.

The central focus of her work is predominately memories and personal experiences. By exploring a variety of mediums and techniques, such as paint, print, sound and video, Alison portrays her concept and ideas in many different ways.

The pieces have become a mixture of concepts, time, story and memories. Through the use of overlaying techniques Parry's works address the difficulties within hidden and repressed memories.

Her latest series is an exploration of the place she grew up. She has used imagery from the countryside where she lived as a starting point; a place where she always feels completely free and at ease.

She always uses distorted text in her work, whether it be written or spoken. She comments on the change both physically within a landscape and emotionally within her, her thoughts and feelings, perhaps those that she never wants to fully reveal.

By pushing the medium far beyond its limits, Parry's artwork is placed within a biographical atmosphere, exploring the intimacies and complexities of her life, yet leaving enough space for the viewer to portray their own perception on life.
